Device Description

The Panacea 6300 series bariatric trapeze is a floor-mounted static device that allows residents to reposition themselves in bed, and is intended for use within an institutional healthcare environment, Application Environment 3 (i.e. Skilled Nursing, Transitional Care, Rehabilitation Care, Assisted Living).

Compliance with the regulations and guidelines as specified by your facility is recommended.

This device is only compatible with Panacea 6300 bariatric beds.

Warnings

Read and follow all directions and warnings before using this device. Do not operate this device without first reading and understanding this manual. Damage or injury may result from improper use of this device. The information contained in this document is subject to change without notice.

WARNING: This device is only a tool as part of an overall care plan. Failure to comply with all instructions, warnings and precautions, or using the device for a purpose other than the recommended use, could result in bodily injury or death. This device is not designed to replace good caregiving practices including, but not limited to:

- Direct patient and resident supervision
- Adequate care plans and training for staff personnel for entrapment and fall prevention
- Inspection and testing before use

THIS DEVICE IS NOT DESIGNED TO MOVE A PATIENT OR RESIDENT IN AND OUT OF BED. **WARNING:** Do not use this device without proper instruction and supervision from a healthcare professional.

WARNING: No part or component of a Panacea 6300 Bariatric Free-Standing Trapeze should be used with non-Panacea beds, lifts or trapezes.

WARNING: After assembly and before use, make sure all attaching hardware is securely tightened.

CAUTION: When using this device for repositioning, care should be taken to ensure the resident at no time is placing his or her entire body weight on the raised head or foot sections of the bed.

WARNING: Supervision is required when this product is operated by or near children or people with disabilities.

Trapeze Package Contents:

- (2) Main Frame Legs
- (1) Mid-Section
- (1) Boom
- (1) Bar and Handle
- (1) Hold-down Bracket
- (12) 1/2" Long Bolts
- (4) 6" Long Bolts
- (16) Washers
- (4) Lock Nuts
- (4) End Caps to go over Lock Nuts

Required Tools for Assembly:

7/32" Hex Key 9/16" Wrench

Prior to installation, verify all package contents have been received in good condition. If components are damaged or missing, contact Direct Supply Equipment & Furnishings immediately. DO NOT use substitute parts or assemble the device while missing parts.

Step 1

Clear a work space and remove all contents from shipping box. You can use the top of the box to place unwrapped items in.

Step 2

Place trapeze legs on floor. Make sure foot pads are on the floor. Next, attach mid-section on the posts coming up from the trapeze legs.

Step 3

Use the (12) ½" long hex bolts and washers to attach the mid-section to the trapeze legs.



Step 4

Use the (4) 6" long hex bolts, washers and lock nuts to attach the trapeze boom to the mid-section.



Step 5

Check to ensure all bolts are tightened and secure. Not doing so may result in injury to the patient/resident or staff.

Step 6

Attach the trapeze handle to an appropriate spot for the resident.



Step 7

If the bed is not in the center of the room, move it to a location that provides access to both sides. Assemble the trapeze hold-down assembly with the open side of the brackets facing the direction shown below. Assemble the hold-down in its shortest configuration using the top holes in the bracket tubes.



Step 8

Raise the bed to its highest position. Insert the trapeze hold-down assembly into the center opening of the bed frame.



Step 9

Slide the assembly forward until the brackets are engaged with the frame tube.



Step 10

Insert the bolt into the bracket from the bottom and tighten knob on end of bolt. Repeat for other side.



YOU HAVE NOW COMPLETED THE ASSEMBLY OF YOUR PANACEA 6300 BARIATRIC FREE-

STANDING TRAPEZE. Be sure to double-check all bolts and part placements on the trapeze. Also, be sure to remove all packaging materials from the area before allowing residents into the area.

Prior to use, be sure to read and refer to the full Owner's Manual for additional warnings. ALWAYS test this device prior to each use.

Cleaning & Maintenance

• The trapeze frame should be cleaned periodically using a mild detergent and water. Be sure to completely dry the trapeze frame before use. When washing the trapeze straps, use only mild detergent and water. DO NOT USE BLEACH. Allow straps to completely air-dry before use. Do not place straps in a dryer.

Prior to First Use Per Patient Maintenance:

- Check and tighten all hardware
- Inspect the frame and strap for wear or damage
- Verify proper function of each feature

Quarterly Maintenance

- Check and tighten all hardware
- Inspect the frame and strap for wear or damage
- Verify proper function of each feature

Limited Warranty

We offer to you, as the original purchaser, a warranty for the Panacea® 6300 Bariatric Free-Standing Trapeze. Our warranty applies for the limited warranty period stated below. If any device or device part listed below is defective in material or workmanship during the applicable limited warranty period, we will repair or replace it at our cost. Please note that the decision to repair or replace a device or device part will be at our discretion. Our warranty applies only if the device is properly maintained by the original purchaser for normal, indoor use and does not cover normal wear and tear, modification of the device, or damage caused by abuse, improper use, failure to maintain, use which exceeds the published device limitations, or the combination of any device with another product. In addition, our warranty does not cover fading, colorfastness, stains, spills or exposure to chemicals, odors, heat or light. In certain cases, we may provide you repair or adjustment instructions and/or replacement parts, and ask you to perform a repair or adjustment or replace a defective part.
