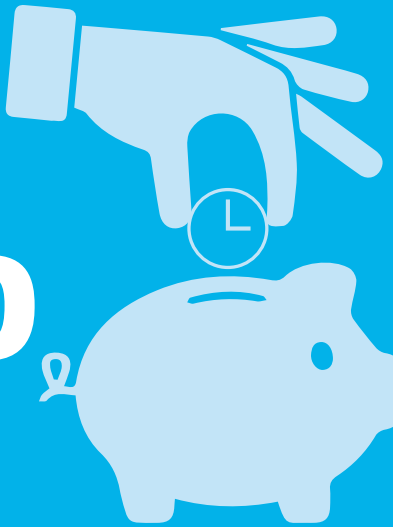

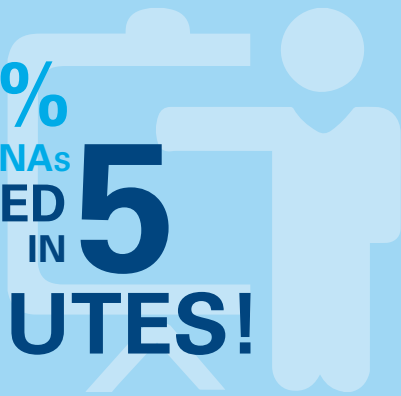

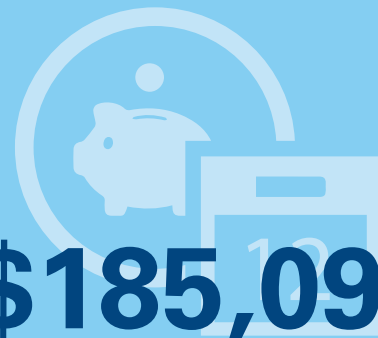

* Calculated using the following assumptions: Vitals taken 1.5 times per day for Aurora's 855 residents at a documentation time savings of 68 seconds, which translates to 8,842 hours of saved time per year. This assumed RNs were documenting one-third of the time and GNAs (CNAs) two-thirds of the time based upon workflow by shift. This was then multiplied by national average hourly wages (via Bureau of Labor Statistics) for Nursing Assistants (\$13.72) and RNs (\$35.36).
