#### Frames:

%" plywood from managed sources. All joints are interlocking and/or glued, screwed and stapled for added strength and rigidity.

## **Seat & Back Suspension:**

Fully upholstered with a foam covering over a high-tensile-strength steel zig-zag sprung platform.

## **Seat Cushion:**


24-28 ILD/2.5 density high-resiliency foam wrapped in foam batting.

## **Back Cushion:**


Pillow back with blown foam fiber. Backrest cushions are attached.

## **Reclining Mechanism:**

**Power Recliner:** Standard power-recline mechanism operated by a corded hand pendant.\*



**Recliner:** Standard 3-position push-back reclining mechanism.





## **Certifications:**

CA117-2013 and CARB II certified. Chair passes BIFMA 5.5X 2014 Seating Standards. CA133 is not available.

## Packaging:

Chair is shipped inside of a box resting on its feet wrapped in plastic. Backrest is not attached and is resting on the seat.

## Floor Glides:

Metal.

## **Limited Warranty:**

- 1-year limited warranty on frame and mechanism.
- 1-year limited warranty on foam.
- Fabric manufacturer's warranty on fabric.
