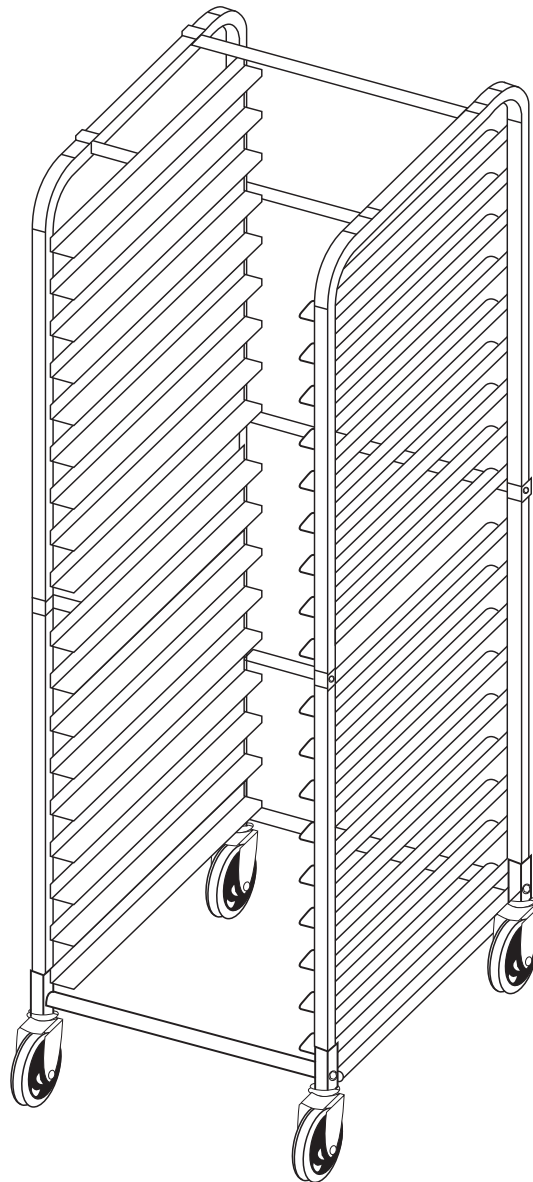

# PAN RACKS & TRANSPORT CABINETS

Owner's Manual and  
Assembly Instructions



## Cleaning of Pan Racks or Transport Cabinets

- Only use cleaning products specified as being aluminum or stainless steel safe, depending on the unit material. Never use chlorides, bromides or iodides to clean the unit, as this may cause corrosion. Consult the label or cleaner manufacturer for proper use.
- Rinse with fresh water immediately after every cleaning, and wipe dry to remove any water residue.
- Do not use any metal brushes, metal cleaning pads or steel wool, as this can cause corrosion.
- Always clean the aluminum or stainless steel in the direction of the metal grain to prevent marking the surface.
- Light and frequent cleanings will prolong the life and appearance of the unit.

Type of Cleaning	Instructions
Typical Cleaning	Use mild soap or detergent diluted with warm water; apply to unit with a clean sponge or cloth. Rinse with clean warm water and wipe dry. Add a small amount of vinegar to solution if a more aggressive cleaning is required.
Smears, Finger Prints, Light Dirt or Discoloration	Use an aluminum or stainless steel cleaner, depending on the unit material. Clean per the instructions on the label.
Grease, Oil or Heavy Soiling	Use a commercial detergent that does not contain chlorides, bromides or iodides. Clean per the instructions on the label.

## Caster Cleaning & Maintenance

Clean the product's casters regularly with mild detergent and water. A scouring pad may be used on rubber treads to remove tough debris. Periodically lubricate the product's casters with multi-temperature-rated axle grease or lubricant. The frequency of lubrication depends on moisture and humidity. See the chart below for further guidelines.

Cleaning Method	Caster Lubrication Frequency
Pressure Steamer	Once a month
Pressure Hose	Four times per year
Wiped down with soap and water	Two times per year

## Pan Rack Assembly Instructions

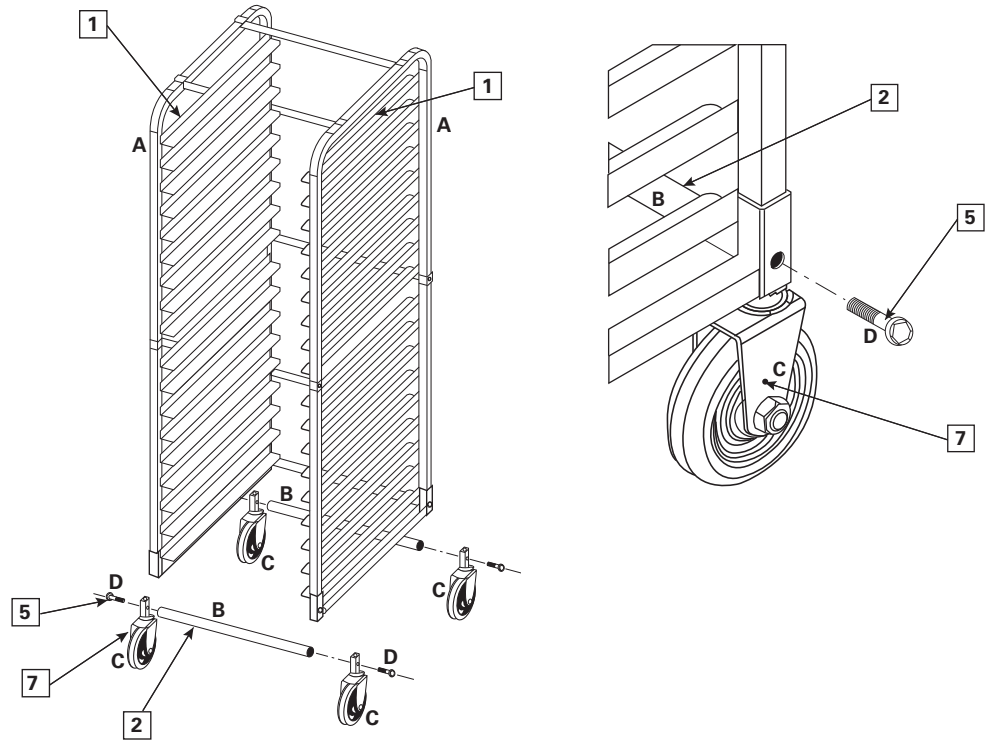
Please follow the instructions below to assemble your Direct Supply® Pan Rack.

1. Open product packaging and locate parts listed in the contents list for the particular unit:

Stainless Pan Rack		
Part	QTY	Description
A	2	Frame
B	6	Cross Bar
C	4	Swivel Caster
D	12	5/16-18 x 1 3/4" Hex Flange Bolt

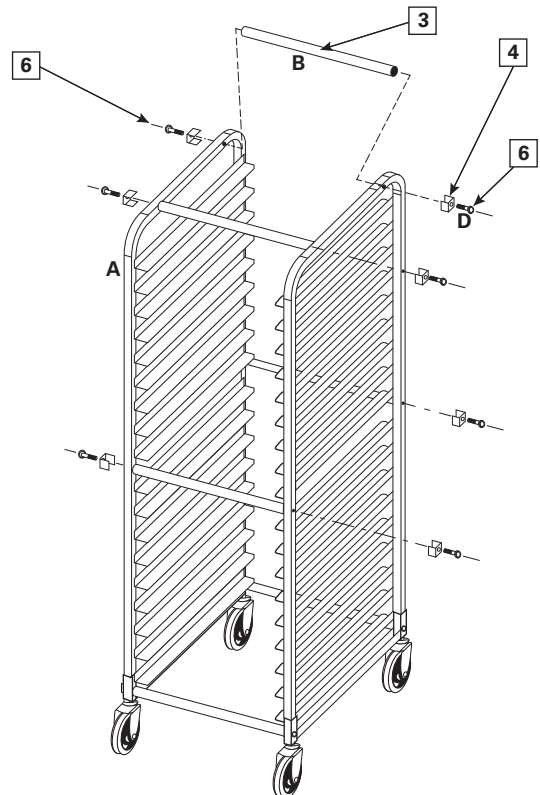
Aluminum Pan Rack		
Part	QTY	Description
1	2	Frame
2	2	1" Cross Bar
3	4	3/4" Cross Bar
4	8	Collar
5	4	3/8-16 x 1 3/4" Hex Flange Bolt
6	8	1/4-20 x 1" Hex Bolt
7	4	Swivel Caster

2. Attach two swivel casters (7 or C) into the base of one of the frame (1 or A) pieces. Next insert the hex bolt (5 or D) through the hole at the top of the caster stem and hand thread into cross bar (2 or B). Repeat with remaining two swivel casters (7 or C) and frame (1 or A). Do not tighten bolts until step 4.



3. Next, attach the remaining four cross bars (3 or B). For stainless steel carts, hand thread bolt (D). For aluminum carts, first place a collar (4) over the outside of the frame and hand thread bolt (6).

4. Tighten all bolts with correct-sized wrench or socket; do not overtighten bolts. Adjust as needed until the cart is level.



## Important Warnings

- The weight limit for this product is 350 lbs.; the weight should be evenly distributed over the unit.
  - Never load an individual shelf with more than 75 lbs.
- Overloading this product could result in the product breaking, as well as damage to property and/or serious injury.
- This product is designed for indoor use ONLY within close proximity of skilled caregivers.
- It is not designed to hold any nonfood tray or items.
- Unit should be kept away from open flames and excessive heat.
- Inspect the product for damage before each use. DO NOT use the product if it appears to be damaged or unstable, and DO NOT alter the product in any way.
- DO NOT overtighten the screws or use power tools when assembling this product.
