Product Description and Care & Maintenance

Product Description & Use

Maxwell Thomas occasional tables are designed for common areas with residential styling in mind. The Maxwell Thomas occasional table offering includes a sofa table, coffee table and an end table in four appealing styles. High-pressure laminate tops resist moisture and hold up to daily use, while a catalyzed lacquer finish covers the wooden legs and aprons.

Care & Maintenance

We recommend the following cleaning practices to help maintain the appearance of the top of your Maxwell Thomas occasional table:

- A top soiled by normal use may be cleaned with liquid dishwashing detergent and warm water.
- For stubborn stains, use a household cleaner that is appropriate for use on wood products.
- Be sure to properly dry all surfaces to prevent moisture damage over time.

△ CAUTION: Do not use 100% bleach, abrasive cleaners, or similar cleaners or chemicals on this product, as such use may void the warranty of this product.

NOTE: Over time, the wooden legs can be scratched or dented from wheelchairs, vacuuming and general use. We recommend the use of an appropriately colored wood stain marker to blend these blemishes to make them less noticeable.

△ CAUTION: Inspect each table every 60 days for sturdiness. Look for loose screws and/or bolts and tighten as needed. If the occasional table is broken remove it from use immediately.



Assembly Instructions


△ **WARNING**: Unpack the occasional table in an area with sufficient room to work. Do not allow residents near the product until it has been completely set up and the work area has been cleared of all debris. Inspect the product for damage. If the product is damaged or the wrong product was accidentally sent, **DO NOT USE IT** and immediately contact Direct Supply Equipment & Furnishings for further instruction.


Tools needed (not included):


- Wrench
- Screw Driver


Hardware Included:

- 4 Screws
- 4 Washers
- 4 Lag Bolts









- Place the tabletop face down on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratching the top (Fig. 1)
- Attach the legs to the table apron at the corners as shown (Fig. 2)
 IMPORTANT DO NOT TIGHTEN the bolts at this time the legs should be able to move in order to assemble the lower shelf
- 3. Once the four legs are attached, slide the lower shelf into the notches on the legs and assemble with screws (Fig. 3)

- 4. Tighten the leg bolts to secure the legs
- 5. Carefully position the table upright be sure to ask for assistance when lifting the table (Fig. 4)
- Periodically check that all of the connections are tight and secure – tighten the bolts or screws as needed

Limited Warranty

We offer to you, as the original purchaser, a warranty for the Maxwell Thomas occasional table. Our warranty applies for the limited warranty period stated below. If any product or product part listed below is defective in material or workmanship during the applicable limited warranty period, we will repair or replace it at our cost. Please note that the decision to repair or replace a product or product part will be at our discretion. Our warranty applies only if the product is properly maintained by the original purchaser for normal, indoor use and does not cover normal wear and tear, modification of the product or damage caused by abuse, improper use, failure to maintain, use which exceeds the published product limitations or the combination of any product with another product. In addition, our warranty does not cover fading, characteristics or natural variations in fabric, texture, colorfastness, stains, spills or exposure to chemicals, odors, heat or light. In certain cases, we may provide you repair or adjustment instructions and/or replacement parts, and ask you to perform a repair or adjustment or replace a defective part. Our warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights, which vary from state to state. Please note that our limited warranty period begins when we ship the product to you.
