

Cover

Low-shear, antimicrobial, fluid-resistant cover

- 4-way stretch top cover wicks away heat and moisture, allows for maximum resident immersion
- Bottom cover: heavy-duty vinyl, fluidproof

Concealed zipper to prevent skin tears and protect foam from liquids

- Extra-large flap covers zipper to prevent contact with skin and prevent fluid from seeping in
- Zipper allows for easy cover removal and replacement if necessary

Mattress Body and Side Bolsters

- 20 8"H air cells provide superior envelopment and pressure redistribution
- Each air cell is individually easily removable for maintenance with quick-disconnects
- Air cells are Velcro[®] attached to the top of side perimeters to minimize gaps and resident falls
- Anchor sheet holds air cells securely in the center to prevent them from separating or migrating from their intended location
- Side perimeters and additional bottom layer of 2"H cells are statically filled and remain inflated in the event of a power outage, preventing bottoming out and falls
- CPR quick release valve allows for emergency deflation for superior resident safety

Control Unit

- Provides alternating pressure on a 10, 15, 20 or 25-minute cycle
- 16 lpm low air loss output
- Low pressure light and audible alarm indicates loss of pressure, increasing resident safety
- Allows for use in static low air loss or alternating pressure with low air loss modes
- Adjustable firmness levels for enhanced resident comfort and clinical efficacy
- Max inflate feature automatically adjusts mattress to maximum firmness
