# Window Treatments: Measuring Guide Worksheet

Following the proportions of your windows helps ensure your treatments won't look too small or too heavy. When measuring your window, make sure to use a rigid measuring device; never use a cloth measuring tape. Fill out the guide below and contact your account manager to order today.

Note: Return is the distance the window treatment mount will protrude from the wall.
