Operating Instructions

Congratulations on purchasing a quality Direct Choice walker. Our Direct Choice walkers are convenient and useful in providing stability and balance in your daily activities. TO ADJUST THE HEIGHT

- With arms relaxed at your side, the handle of the walker should be at wrist height. Or with your hand on the handgrip, your arms should be flexed 20° - 30°.
- 2. To adjust, press the spring button on each leg, moving the leg up or down.
- 3. Once all legs are even for a level walker, make sure the spring button on each leg is secure in its hole.

TO WALK WITH THE WALKER

- 1. Start with the middle of your foot even with the walker's back legs.
- 2. Pick the walker up and place it in front of you. Be sure all four legs are on the floor.
- 3. Then carefully step forward, one foot at a time.

TO CLEANTHE HANDLE GRIPS

1. Clean grips with mild soap or detergent and never use organic solvents that could dissolve the grips (such as turpentine, acetone, gasoline, etc.).
